And when I say growth, I don't mean just in the number in worship, but also in the faith and spirituality of those who are a part of our family here.

I'm moving to Fredericktown UMC and am looking forward to serving that charge and all the great ministry that I will get to take part in there, but if you continue the hard work you all have done, if you continue to grow in your faith, if you continue to grow in your service, and if you continue to grow in your evangelism, just as you have over the last several years together and embrace change that has to come when it comes, then I have no doubt that what's been happening at Maple Church over these last several years is only the beginning of a great and joyous future.

I look forward to hearing through the connection of all the great works Maple Church has in the years ahead of it. I may be moving, but it is my heartfelt prayer that the ministry and mission of Maple Church are here to stay in more powerful ways than ever before.

**MAY 23RD, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Darryl Pannier at 6:04 PM. Pastor Bryan voiced the opening prayer.

**LEARNING:** Learning time at this One Council meeting was led by Pastor Bryan. Instead of starting a new book, he will talk about the transition of new pastors and moving. He will be preaching every Sunday in June except for the weekend he is gone to Annual Conference. That Sunday Sue Batchelor will be delivering the message as it is her Sunday on the rotation of Lay servants. He noted that typically he would move on 26<sup>th</sup> and Pastor Jeff would move in on the 27<sup>th</sup>. Instead this time he will be moving sometime the week of the 18<sup>th</sup>. He noted that the carpeting is in poor shape much of it due to the way it was laid. This early move by him will leave us more days to do what we would like to do to get the parsonage ready. He will be staying on Saturday night the 24<sup>th</sup> and will leave after church on Sunday to go to Fredericktown. He also had a baton that was given to Maple by the DS which he will be working into the sermon series as a blessing that can be passed to Pastor Jeff. Pastor Jeff will be able to put in his office with all the blessings attached. Pastor Bryan will leave on the communion table his last Sunday and Pastor Jeff will pick up from communion table his first Sunday. The object of the blessings and sermon series will be the new mission statement. The mission statement will not end with the transition that way.

**REPORTING:** Alex made a motion to accept the minutes as published. Frank seconded and motion carried. The calendar was updated and finalized. Financial reports were submitted by Becky Hann. Terry Biddle was absent from the meeting so there was no Memorial fund report. Frank made a motion to accept report as submitted and Lavonna seconded. Motion carried. Finance committee: no report.

**PPR:** The contract for Pastor Jeff was presented. Alex made a motion that we accept as presented. Lavonna seconded and motion carried. Trustees: The roof on the deck at the parsonage still needs to be fixed and the work to get the parsonage ready for Pastor Jeff is the current priority.

However, he noted that we need to think about our vision for Maple during the first 6 months of Pastor Jeff's leadership and during that time we need to find out what Pastor Jeff's vision for Maple looks like. Sue B will be in charge of VBS and Alex the lock-in. We will need assistance from the members of the church and parents. There will be a meeting in early June for planning. We will also have our next meeting in July with the new pastor. The theme of VBS is SUPER HEROES.

**NEW BUSINESS:** We broke into a closed meeting as it had to do with employment issues. The next One Council meeting will be TUESDAY, July 11 at 6:00 PM in order to meet with the new Pastor early in the month.
